This Court has previously issued a series of emergency orders intended to address the substantial health and safety risks faced by the public accessing the courts, court personnel, and participants in court proceedings caused by the community spread of the coronavirus. The most recent such emergency order was entered by this Court on February 17, 2022. Since no counties in Idaho are currently subject to crisis standards of care and incident rates are generally lower across the state, we have concluded that rescission of the safety protocols set forth in this Court's February 17, 2022, Order is warranted.

Recognizing the need for a reasonable period of time for courts, court personnel, and participants to adapt their processes and practices for the return to regular court operations, this order shall not become effective until April 1, 2023. On April 1, 2023, this Court's February 17, 2022, Order re: Emergency Order Regarding Court Services shall be rescinded.
