WHEREAS, in the course of annual county budget proceedings, the Trial Court Administrator and the Administrative District Judge have been asked by various Boards of County Commissioners to review the law library budgets and expenditures of the counties and to implement Idaho Court Administrative Rule 41 in the Fifth Judicial District; and

WHEREAS, in addition to I.C.A.R. 41, Idaho Code §31-825 provides that each county shall purchase and provide such law books and pamphlets as the county commissioners may judge from time to time to be necessary for use of the district court and the county officials and bar of the county; and

WHEREAS, Idaho Court Administrative Rule 41 provides that the Administrative District Judge of each judicial district shall have the authority and power to provide for adequate law libraries for the district courts as part of the necessary facilities and equipment necessary for the District Courts and Magistrate Courts to function and carry out their judicial responsibilities.

THEREFORE, pursuant to I.C.A.R. 41, and to the extent not paid by the state, each county shall be required to provide the following:

For each Judge:

- A Current set of the Idaho Code. *
- A complete set of the Idaho Reports. *, **
- A current Idaho State Bar Desk Book.
- A Law Dictionary.
- A paid subscription to West Law Computerized Legal Research as contracted for by the Idaho Supreme Court.
- A current set of the Idaho Pattern Jury Instruction, both civil and criminal.

For all Judges combined:

- One set of the County Ordinances and one set of the City Codes of municipalities within the county.
- A complete set of the Idaho Reports.*
- A complete set of the Idaho Digest.
- A treatise of Idaho Law on evidence
- Subscription to Idaho Law Review of College of Law of the University of Idaho.
- A treatise of Criminal Law and Procedure.
- Annual Session Laws of Idaho.*

IN ADDITION to the above, and on a county by county basis, the respective boards of county commissioners may provide such additional books and library resources as the respective commission may judge from time to time to be necessary for other county officials and the bar of the county. I.C. §31-825.
