ADMINISTRATIVE ORDER

WHEREAS, Idaho Courts have a preference for the concept of one family one judge; and

WHEREAS, Twin Falls County has an active Child Protection Act Family Drug Court which involves families who have active Child Protection Act cases involving their children; and

WHEREAS, it would be in the best interests of the families and children involved in both Child Protection Act Family Drug Court and Child Protection act cases to have one judge preside over their cases both in Child Protection Act Family Drug Court and in the Child Protection Act Cases; and

WHEREAS, having one judge preside over both the Child Protection Act Family Drug Court and the Child Protection Act cases would be in the best interests of judicial economy;

NOW THEREFORE, IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that the Magistrate Judge assigned to preside over the Child Protection Act Drug Court shall also be assigned each Child Protection Act case where a party or parties have been accepted into and are actively participating in the Child Protection Act Drug Court. Said assignments shall be made immediately.
