WHEREAS, the position of Child Protection Drug Court Liaison for the Fifth Judicial District was created and funded through the Idaho Department of Health & Welfare, and;

WHEREAS, this court finds that the Liaison is a professional working under the supervision of the Fifth Judicial District Administrative Judge for purposes of Idaho Administrative Rule 32(o)(5); and

WHEREAS, the scope of the Child Protection Drug Court Liaison's employment includes knowing the content of the entire file including the "confidential" portions

for the purpose of carrying out his/her appointed duties as Liaison for the Child Protection Drug Court for the Fifth Judicial District; and

WHEREAS, the Child Protection Drug Court Liaison shall keep all information obtained pursuant to this order strictly confidential except as may be necessary in the performance of their duties as the Child Protection Drug Court Liaison.

THEREFORE, the Administrative District Judge hereby ORDERS, pursuant Idaho Administrative Rule 32(o)(5), that the Child Protection Drug Court Liaison shall have access to all records of the parties in the appointed case, including:

- 1. Any Fifth Judicial District case in which the parties or their minor children in the appointed case were/are a party, including criminal cases, civil cases, child protection actions, juvenile correction proceedings, and/or domestic violence petitions.
- 2. Upon agreement of the appointing judge, any other Fifth Judicial District case which may contain information relevant to the appointed case.
