ORDER SETTING DISTRICT PROBLEM SOLVING COURT FEES, I.C. § 31-3201E.

ADMINISTRATIVE ORDER 19-05

Eric J. Wildman, Administrative District Judge of the Fifth Judicial District, pursuant to Idaho Code § 31-3201(E), hereby orders that:

- 1. As established in Administrative Order 2009-03, issued June 15, 2009, any person accepted into a problem solving court in the Fifth Judicial District shall be required to pay a fee not to exceed \$300.00 per month.
- 2. Pursuant to Idaho Code § 31-3201(E), current fees are set by the administrative district judge for participants. For good cause, the judge presiding over a drug court or mental health court may exempt a participant from paying all or a portion of the drug court and mental health court fee.
- 3. The current fees per month for the following Problem Solving Courts of the Fifth Judicial District are as follows:

DUI Court	\$100
Drug Court	\$125
Juvenile Drug Court	\$25
Minidoka Juvenile Drug Court	\$0
Veterans Treatment Court	\$100
Misdemeanor Mental Health Court	\$0
Felony Mental Health Court	\$35

- 4. All fees collected pursuant to this order shall be receipted and disbursed as set forth in I.C. § 31-3201(E).
- 5. In the event of a fee change, the problem solving court coordinator shall forthwith notify the Trial Court Administrator for the Fifth Judicial District.
