ORDER PRESCRIBING COUNTY PRETRIAL RELEASE FUNCTIONS AND SETTING COUNTY PRETRIAL RELEASE SUPERVISION FEES, I.C.§ 31-880.

ADMINISTRATIVE ORDER 19-08

Idaho Code §31-880 provides that the board of county commissioners may establish a supervised pretrial release program to perform those functions as prescribed by the administrative district judge in each judicial district. Establishment of such a program, however, is not obligatory.

Eric J. Wildman, Administrative District Judge of the Fifth Judicial District, pursuant to Idaho Code 31-880 and Idaho Code §31-3201(J), hereby orders that:

- 1. Pursuant to Idaho Code §31-880, county commissions in the Fifth Judicial District, who choose to establish supervised pretrial release programs, shall use the program to ensure the pretrial supervision, as set by the presiding judge, and to ensure the attendance of defendant at subsequent court proceedings.
- 2. A supervised pretrial release program shall perform the function of monitoring and supervision for compliance with any reporting requirements imposed by the presiding judge or pretrial release representative. Monitoring and supervision may include, but is not limited to, the performing of test of blood, breath, urine, saliva, hair or other bodily fluid or tissues, compliance with curfews or other directives relating to living circumstances, activities or personal associations or the like, and the use and monitoring of SCRAM and GPS Units.
- 3. Pursuant to Idaho Code §3201(J)1, current fees are set by the administrative district judge for participants. Any person under a supervised pretrial release program in the Fifth Judicial District may be required to pay an amount of not more than the maximum monthly misdemeanor probation supervision fee.
- 4. The pretrial release supervision fees for counties of the Fifth Judicial District, as previously set by county resolution, are as follows:

Blaine County	\$0.00
Camas County	\$0.00
Cassia County	\$0.00
Gooding County	\$0.00
Jerome County	\$50.00/One Time Fee
Lincoln County	\$0.00
Minidoka County	\$0.00
Twin Falls County	\$2.50 Daily

- 5. All fees collected pursuant to Idaho Code §31-3201J(3) shall be paid to the clerk of the district court, who shall pay such fees to the county treasurer to be used exclusively to cover the costs of the pretrial services provided by such agency that has been designated to provide pretrial release services.
- 6. In the event of any change to the supervision fee, the County Clerk shall forthwith notify the Trial Court Administrator for the Fifth Judicial District.
