

## **SCHEDULING AND CO-PARENTING WEBSITES & APPS**

**Our Family Wizard-** <https://www.ourfamilywizard.com/>

Our Family Wizard Helps parents with various areas of scheduling and communication needs. It includes a color-coded custody calendar where you can keep track of your parenting schedule, including pick-up and drop-off times. The app also has a journal entry feature and allows parents to send and receive messages to one another also including a “read receipt” feature as well as a “tone meter” when drafting communication to your co-parent. There’s also a feature that allows parents to keep track of shared expenses for the child/ren, immunization records, emergency contacts, and more.

Although Cozi Family Organizer isn’t geared specifically towards co-parenting, it is widely utilized as general family planner. Parents can use Cozi to create a color-coded calendar enabling them to distinguish between each child’s activities, and when co-parenting, to designate separate parenting times. This calendar can be shared with your co-parent and send reminders for important events. The app includes a “to-do” list feature, family journal, and a feature designed to store shopping lists and recipes.

Fayr is an application specifically designed with co-parenting in mind. It has a simplistic design and flow and includes many useful features for the practical-minded parent. The app features a shared calendar that both parents can access, complete with a geo location log. For instance, if, during your parenting time, you are taking the children camping, you can check-in at your location on the app via GPS, so your co-parent knows where the children are. Parents can also message via the app and utilize the feature which allows parents to track expenses. Plus, all expense reports can be exported as time-stamped PDF for efficient record-keeping.

### **Google Calendar**

Google Calendar is a standard go-to for parents who love to keep schedules and paperwork organized. The app is easy to navigate and any events you discuss via email, including digital ticket receipts, flights, or hotel confirmations, will be added to your calendar for a smooth integration. You can also share events with your co-parent, which can make it easier for both of you to sync your parenting schedules, make changes, and keep track of big events in your child/ren’s lives.

The 2houses app is designed specifically for separated and divorced families. The system includes a shared calendar for easy scheduling and a detailed expense report to keep track of anything purchased for the child. Additionally, the app has an “Information bank” feature that allows parents to share things like report cards, medical information, release forms and other important documents. 2houses is available in

Another app designed specifically for co-parenting, AppClose offers several convenient features with no subscription fees or monthly charges. Parents can share a calendar, message one another, track expenses, and store important documents. The app also features a handy “request” section that allows parents to officially request and approve things like reimbursements for child-related expenses, changes in drop-off times, etc.

Talking Parents is a co-parenting application which allows parents to have a secure place to exchange information, keep track of records which are stored in chronological order. Parents can know their communications are stored securely without the worry of losing records or tampering of records sent by each parent. The application also provides a feature which allows parents to know the status of sent messages and includes a time and “view state” of shared messages and files.
